3rd Annual Benefit Dinner and Silent Auction Proceeds to benefit the Gabbard Campaign

Central Baptist College is pleased to announce the third annual Benefit Dinner and Silent Auction to be held on Saturday, February 6, 2010 in the Mabee Student Services Complex. All of the proceeds from this event will benefit the Gabbard Campaign, which is a campaign to name the new science center in honor of Mrs. Judy Gabbard for her work and dedication to the CBC Science Department. The fundraising goal for this event is \$25,000.

The silent auction and appetizer buffet will open at 5:30 P.M. followed by dinner and the program at approximately 6:30 P.M. Dinner this year will be prepared by Central Baptist College Dining Services, under the direction of executive chef, Jill McCollum, and will consist of assorted breads with herbed butter, seafood bisque, chicken Wellington, petite roasted potatoes, company carrots, and dessert. Special guest for this event will be CBC Alum, Jeremy Riddle, who serves as Campaign Co-Chair.

Individual tickets are \$25.00 and sponsorships range from \$250 to \$2,500. In order for sponsors to have their name and/or logo (dependent on sponsorship level) listed on promotional materials, sponsorship forms and payment must be received at Central Baptist College prior to February 1, 2010.

The first Benefit Dinner and Silent Auction was held in 2008 in conjunction with Homecoming activities and raised \$15,000 towards the purchase of a 33 passenger bus which is currently in use by CBC's athletic teams and music performance groups. Over \$10,000 was raised in 2009 and will be used to purchase exercise equipment for the new Campus Fitness Center. A total of 23 businesses and individuals sponsored this event last year.
