<u>US Territories Stipend/</u> <u>Scholarship</u>

Individuals from US Territories are eligible for a financial aid package consisting of Federal and Institutional aid here at Central Baptist College.

If students from US Territories would like to attend CBC, they will fall under the guidelines set forth by following:

- 1. Mandatory housing and meal plan (\$8,500 annually).
- 2. Mandatory 15 credit hours per semester (@ \$550.00 per credit hour = \$16,500).
- 3. General Fees = \$1,500 \$2,000 Annually (Science and Math Lab Fees, etc.)
 - a. Total Annual cost: \$27,000

Students from US Territories will receive a CBC general stipend of \$8,000 taken directly from the Annual cost, making the amount owed \$19,000 for the year. CBC is now able to offer an additional \$4,000 institutional stipend, which then reduces the amount owed by the student to be \$15,000.

\$15,000 minus the amount of funds awarded from FAFSA Pell Grant (If qualified through Federal Aid Application and/or Federal Student Loans (Optional). Final cost will vary per student due to federal qualifications, etc.

• Book cost varies depending on the book requirement per class.
